Theme: Winter

What is the Winter Solstice?

The Winter Solstice is the day that marks midwinter and features the least daylight hours out of any in the year. It occurs when either the South or the North Pole reaches its maximum tilt away from the sun. This means that the sun rises later and sets sooner than at any other point in the yearly calendar.

In 2024, the winter solstice in the northern hemisphere will occur on Saturday 21 December.

Possible ideas

- write a poem all about winter
- cook a meal perfect for cold winter nights
- create a piece of artwork based around winter
- create snowflakes from paper or cotton buds
