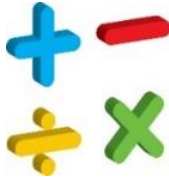
# Maths

## Number and Place Value:

## Addition and Subtraction:

## Fractions:

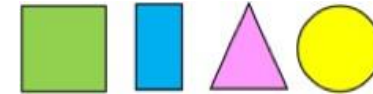
- Recognise, find, name and write  $\frac{1}{3}$ ,  $\frac{1}{4}$ ,  $\frac{2}{4}$  and  $\frac{3}{4}$  of lengths, shapes and quantities.
- Write simple fractions, e.g.  $\frac{1}{2}$  of 6 = 3.

## Measure:

- Recognise notes and coins
- Count, make and compare amounts of money
- Calculate with money and find change
- Compare and order lengths and heights
- Measure in metres and centimetres
- Compare mass
- Measure in grams and kilograms
- Compare volume and capacity
- Measure in litres and millilitres
- Use all 4 operations with length, height, mass, volume and capacity
- Intervals of time.
- Tell the time to the nearest 5 minutes.
